Budgeting For Massage Therapy School

Tuition payment options

As a full-time licensed college, all of our students are eligible to apply for student loans and grants, as well as other sources of funding assistance. But whether you're getting a loan or paying out of pocket, it's great to be able to spread the cost out over the year. This is why we have an in-house tuition instalment plan, available to all students. It breaks up your tuition into three payments, at regular intervals through the school year.

For example, here is the first-year tuition payment schedule:

Registration Deposit	First Day of Class	Second Instalment (Sept. students: February 1) (Jan. students: April 1)	Third Instalment (Sept. students: May 1) (Jan. students: July 1)	Total
\$250	\$4,700	\$2,475	\$2,475	\$9,900

Your second-year payments will look almost identical to the first year. We don't ask you for your second-year tuition until the beginning of that year.

Textbooks and other school costs

In addition to your tuition, you will need to factor the cost of textbooks and school supplies into your education budget. When you are calculating your budget, include the following approximate expenses.

Mandatory fees:

Technology fee (paid each year)	\$100
Lab & Facilities fee (paid each year)	\$100

Books and resources:

Textbook amount first year	\$637
Textbook amount second year	\$180
Optional textbooks	\$102

Miscellaneous costs for first year:

Massage table	\$500
Lotions, linens, incidentals	\$200
Computer / Tablet	\$500
First Aid/CPR training	\$150
Scrubs	\$80

Miscellaneous cost for second year:

Lotions, linens, incidentals	\$100
Computer / Tablet	\$500
Association memberships (optional)	\$650
